

ALLIED HEALTH STEPS FOR ADMISSIONS

SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE THE HESI ADMISSIONS EXAM

Minimum passing scores are below:

- Central Sterile Processing Technology: **30 in math, 60 in reading**
- Dental Assisting: **50 in math, 60 in reading**
- Pharmacy Technician: **45 in math, 70 in reading**
- Surgical Technology: **70 in math, 70 in reading**
- ACT scores are accepted as long as the student is 20 years of age or under and scores must be 19 in all parts - Math, Reading & English. A 19 composite score is not acceptable.

SUBMIT AN ONLINE APPLICATION FOR ENROLLMENT

Visit www.tcatmurfreesboro.edu/apply. After completing the online application, mail or submit in person the following requirements:

- **High school diploma** OR transcript OR GED/HiSet
- **Proof of MMR immunization** (if born 01/01/1957 or after)
- **Proof of Varicella Zoster immunization** (if born 01/01/1980 or after)
- **Passing HESI exam scores** or ACT scores

If you submit documentation via email or mail, contact the Student Services office to confirm your documents have been received.

PARTIAL APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

CHECK YOUR MAIL OR EMAIL

Upon each Allied Health program's deadline, the program's instructor will assess completed applications. All applicants who submit completed applications will be notified by mail and/or email as to whether they are accepted or not. This process will take one month.

NOTE: Completion of testing and/or prerequisites does not guarantee admittance. Applicants should be aware that acceptance into an Allied Health Program is a **competitive process** and will be based on the highest test scores and/or prerequisite averages. Allied Health Programs are chosen from all applicants that have completed the requirements by the deadline. **(Applications that remain incomplete after the program's deadline, will not be considered into the Allied Health Program for that year.)** You may reapply for the program's next start date the following year.
